GANDHI JAGRUTI YATRA:

On request from Sudarshan Iengar - VC of Gujarat Vidyapith, Jeevantirth took lead role to organize "Dandi/Karadi – Dharasana Padyatra" from 6th April to 10th April 2011. Dandi, famous for "Namak Satyagrah" by Gandhiji is declared as place of national importance and MoEF has lunched Green Action for National Dandi Heritage Initiative (GANDHI) Memorial Project at the initial outlay of Rs. 25 crores. The project aims for the overall development and conservation of the environment of Dandi and its surrounding village based on Gandhian Teachings on Environmental Conservation and Village Development.

Jeevantirth's team with "School on Wheels" campaigned with exhibitions, leaflets, puppet and plays in 30 nearby villages and spread the message of Gandhian thoughts. About 100 participants including Freedom Fighters, Social Activists and Students joined the yatra. Series of programs were organized during the yatra. Jeevantirth team gave about a month's time to make it a great success.

Our 100 day program equips unemployed youth (of 18 years or more) with vocational skills and life-skills that ensures employment with reputed organizations at the end of the training program. In addition to imparting knowledge and skill sets in various vocations like Security and Retail Marketing, we train the youth in life skills like Spoken English, Basic Computer Usage, Communication Skills, Value Education and Citizenship Training. QUALITY EDUCATION PROGRAM AT GNKM – THAVA:

With the active support of Caring Friends under the leadership of Kaushikbhai Shah in the fields of Quality Education, Infrastructural Development, Management Information System and Financial Practices Improvement; GNKM is showing slowly but steadily remarkable changes. As a partner organization of "Caring Friends", Jeevantirth implemented QEP at GNKM Thava. In the year 2008-2009, SSC result was only 5.44 %. In the year 2009-2010 41.71 % cleared the exam. Result of SSC shoots up to 90% in 2010-11.

BAL SANSKAR KENDRAS:

With the generous support from "Arpan Foundation" now we are running five centres in the area. Two other centres are supported by another local trust. The class begins with a Prayer, Recitation and devotional Song. Then as per the Period System two subjects are chosen for the day in rotation based on student's requirement. 30 minutes time is allotted to each subject. About 30 minutes are given for fun and other creative activities like — Drawing, Painting, Origami, Art and Craft, Games and Sports, Exercises, Yoga and Meditation, Songs and Plays etc. Each child is given Identity Card and Progress Report to monitor her/his progress. Three groups - A, B, C are formed looking to their educational performance in the class.

TRIBAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT:

As an active support organization of "Aadi Aushadhi Group" – Traditional Healer's Group of Dediapada, Himmat of Jeevantirth coordinated most of the activities round the year. This year our strategic thrust was on "Irrigation Support". Four Diesel Engines were purchased for Lift Irrigation, few wells were deepened and new wells were dug. Irrigation Pipes and Drum Drip Irrigation Systems are in process. Land leveling and Farm bunding resulted in the raise of income up Rs. 15,000 to 20,000 to the members. Selling of value added products like Mahuda Ice-cream, Mahuda Biscuits, Brahmi Khari and Gota, Shataveri/Ashvagandha Biscuit etc. fetched them good profit. Herbal Medicines of Aadi Aushadhi has become popular and earned great reputation.
