Role:

Gujarat is the leading state in the race of urbanization in the whole of India. According to 2011 census data the urban population of Gujarat was 42.2 percent which is about 2.57 crores and it is estimated to grow to 44.46 percent by 2021. Factors like increasing population, decreasing cultivable land and lack of natural resources have forced many villagers to migrate to the cities in search of employment. Most of them dwell in slums or makeshift huts. Even if this struggling community is provided with basic services like electricity, water, roads and sanitation, they would still be devoid of quality education, clean and health conducive environment, cultural and life enhancing activities, citizenship training and opportunities for scope of development.

In regard to this, Jeevantirth began working with the largest slum of Ahmedabad, RamapirNo Tekro and its surrounding regions like Ganeshnagar, Balolnagar, Ranip-Nirnaynagar in 2009-2010. With the help of dedicated volunteers, local support and well-wishers of Jeevantirth we have been able to understand their issues deeply and work with them accordingly. We heartily invite you to be a part of various activities going on at Jeevantirth.

|| For Our Children ||

Bal Sankar Kendras

Large number of children are now being enrolled into schools. However, children of deprived communities are forced out of the education system owing to the lack of quality education. We help these children achieve benchmarks of minimum level of learning at our Bal Sanskar Kendras. Moreover they enjoy learning value education, life-skill education and activity based learning. 500 children from RamapirNo Tekro and surrounding slums are being provided with quality education thorough 15 Bal Sanskar Kendras.

Girl-child Education Program

Manav Sadhana is in charge of about 79 Aanganvaadis operating in and around RamapirNo Tekro. These Aanagvaadis have 'Sakhi Mandals' which comprise of more than 1800 teenage girls. Jeevantirth designs various educational activities for them and trains the Aanganvaadi workers to conduct them effectively.

Topics related to our rights and responsibilities, body literacy, legal literacy, economic literacy and various lifeskill education are being elucidated by us. Community education is effectively being taught through the medium of visual aids.

SHGs of rag-picker women

Approximately 7000 women from RamapirNo Tekro begin their day at 3 AM by collecting waste. They walk 10 to 15 kilometers collecting paper, glass, plastic, cardboards, etc. and make 70 to 80 rupees daily, hardly making ends meet. 500 such women save 200 rupees on a monthly basis which helps provide loans to women in need regarding health, education or employment. Moreover, this helps them obtain household items like wheat, rice, oil, gas connection, etc. at a lower cost and in installments. Life related training is given to the women during group and monthly meetings.

Vocational Training Centres

With the help of Unnati-Bangalore, Jeevantirth provides vocational training to youth from opportunity-deprived communities. They are trained in fields of retail marketing, beauty parlor, office assistant - Tally, sewing etc. for 50 days, after which they pridefully take on respectful jobs. We carry out various activities to cultivate a personal and self-improvement attitude in youth. This aims at them becoming responsible citizens and becoming actively involved in social-interest activities.

Role:

Dediapada, a taluka located in South Gujarat, is a tribal region that belongs to the Narmada district. It comprises of 214 villages that are distributed across the region. Since many years Jeevantirth has been conducting programs for tribal research and development with the help of various voluntary, government and semi-government organizations. The programs are as follows:

Strengthening of 'Aadi Aushadhi Group'

The formation of Aadi Aushadhi group with members of traditional healers (bhagats) of Dediapada was done in leadership of Fr. Lancy by St. Xavier's College Society. We help this group in soil and water conservation, cultivation of medicinal plants and preparation of medicinal products and lead them on road to holistic development.

With help of Van Vikas Nigam, Gujarat Medicinal Plant Board and MNREGA, we develop nurseries and distribute medicinal plant saplings.

Value Added Healthy Food Products


AAG created food products like brahmi khakhra, ashwagandhashatavari biscuits, apamarg khaari, khaatibhindi sharbet, mahuda ice cream etc. and they became widely admired.

Jeevantirth received help for bakery project from NABARD, which is being managed by tribal women.

Jeevantirth received multi-purpose food processing machine from 'National Innovative Foundation' and with its help, products like various oils, aloe vera shampoo and juices are also being produced.


