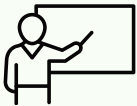

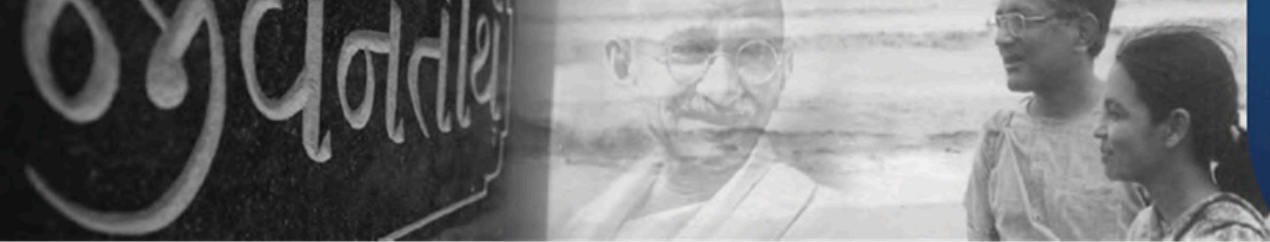

The programs—*Kalrav, Balvatika, Baal Sanskar Kendra, Anubandh, and Gunjan*—are designed with a shared intention of nurturing holistic development, ensuring that children grow not only academically but also emotionally, socially, and confidently.

***Together, these initiatives reached over 2,700+ children across 35+ schools and centres, creating inclusive learning spaces through interactive sessions and life centred activities.*** While Kalrav and Balvatika focus on joyful early childhood development, Baal Sanskar Kendra and Gunjan strengthen foundational literacy and school readiness, and Anubandh supports adolescents in building life skills, self-awareness, and values.

Through this continuum, the programs aim to transform hesitant learners into confident, expressive individuals, while fostering a strong connection between children, schools, and communities.



***In the heart of Sabarnagar and Chandrabhaga, 134 children found a space to belong and grow.*** With 126 children attending regularly, learning became a habit, not a struggle. From 0 children in ‘Good’ category at baseline to 35+ at endline, transformation became visible.



What began as hesitation slowly turned into confidence, curiosity, and joyful participation. ***Ahaan is not just a centre—it is where children rediscover their voice and self-belief.***

***Sabarnagar centre is a Power House which also serves as “a child resource Centre” to train other Baalmitras.***

# Nature Education Programs

Through a blend of experiential learning, community engagement, and value-based education, Jeevantirth's Nature Education Programs nurtured a deep connection between children and the environment. **Across six integrated initiatives, over 11,000 children from urban, rural, and slum communities were engaged in hands-on activities, nature exposure, and leadership-building experiences.** From classrooms to camps and communities, children not only gained awareness but demonstrated visible behavioural shifts—adopting sustainable practices like reducing plastic use, conserving water, and celebrating eco-friendly lifestyles. **These programs are shaping a generation of sensitive, responsible, and action-oriented young citizens who carry the spirit of nature into their everyday lives.**

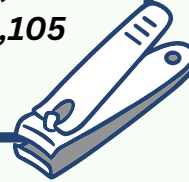
## Read Panchmahal

The Read Panchmahal Programme, implemented across **20 schools** in Halol (Panchmahal); reached **3,182 children** from Balvatika to Grade 8 through joyful, activity-based learning. Foundational literacy and numeracy were strengthened through structured Gujarati and Mathematics modules. **Value Addition was ensured by Life centred experiential learning initiatives like “Vigyan Ganga” Science on Wheels and “Gyanganga” – Life Centered Education.** Digital exposure was enhanced through the learning platform “Melzo”, & “Anubhav” VR experience for Grades **6–8**; making complex concepts immersive and engaging.



### 100,000 Nail Cutter Project

Our dream project of the year was to reach 100,000 children with a small gift of love, a Nail Cutter, to nurture personal hygiene habits in children. **The Nail Cutter Project promoted hygiene across 402 schools, distributing 72,710 nail cutters, 69,557 hygiene guides, and 1,105 posters, driving behavioral change.**



## Abhivyakti

**Abhivyakti is a living space for expression where learning unfolds through connection with self, community and nature.**

Now operational at Juna Koba, the riverside campsite hosted around **13 camps** and trainings in 2025–26—including summer, nature, and experiential programs for women, teachers, and youth—marking a meaningful beginning after its developmental phase.



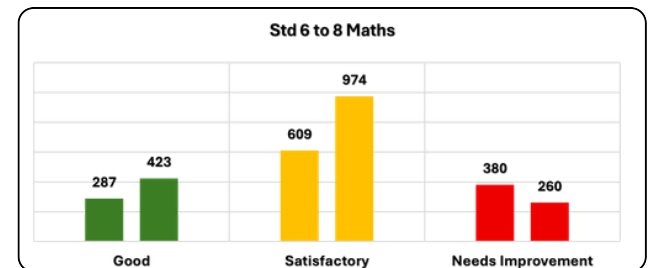
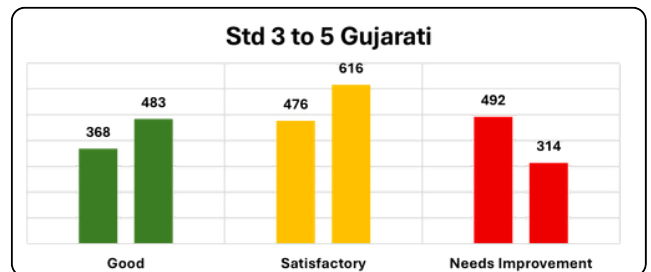
# GyanDeep - Transforming Classrooms, Touching Lives

**With the support of AIA Engineering Ltd., 5,114 children across 11 schools began a journey where they felt seen, heard, and encouraged.** With 6 Baalmitras, classrooms slowly transformed into spaces of joy, curiosity, and belonging. Children who once hesitated are now speaking, participating, and believing in themselves, reflected even in improved learning levels. Learning moved beyond books—into stories, nature, play, and real-life experiences.

What changed most is not just numbers, but the smile, confidence, and spark in every child.

## Urban Initiatives

The **Gyanprabha** Project, implemented by Jeevantirth with the support of Arhant Foundation, is a holistic education initiative reaching **490+ children** (ages 3–14) across **8 community centres** and mobile learning units.

Structured through Kalrav, Balvatika, and Baal Sanskar Kendra, the program delivers age-appropriate, experiential learning through play-based activities, storytelling, and real-life exposure. **Beyond academics, it focuses on building confidence, values, and life skills; supported by strong community engagement, parental involvement, and continuous teacher training—creating a foundation for lifelong learning and holistic development.**

A new Partnership with ‘**Dabhoi Community Foundation – USA**’ and Jeevantirth began from **June 2025** for Educational and Community Development Programs in **Dabhoi**. Jeevantirth proposed ‘**Anganwadi Support Program (ASP)**’, and DCF readily agreed to support the training and engagement of **25 Anganwadi centres**. *The villages covered under the program mainly covers Tribal communities, rehabilitated under the Narmada River Vally Development Project, Sardar Sarovar Dam.*

## Vocational Training

At **Primary School Bhalaniya (Godhra, Panchmahal)**, a 6-month vocational training program introduced basic stitching and Mehendi skills for students of **Grades 5–8**, benefiting all children.

Students learned practical skills like bag making, cloth repair, and creative design, building confidence and self-reliance.

Aligned with initiatives like the **Gyandeep** project in **Lodariyal Primary School**, nearly **100 girls** were trained in beauty parlour skills including Mehendi and stitching on sewing machines.

*Such pre-vocational exposure is enabling children to build confidence and life skills beyond academics.*



## Strengthening Biodiversity Committees

Jeevantirth was instrumental in facilitating PBRs (Public Biodiversity Registers) of all the villages of **Dediapada** taluka district Narmada. **Ministry of Aayush - NMPB sectioned grant for “Ethnomedicinal Network Linkages in 6 clusters” of 12 BMCs of Dediapada.** The project delayed for 2 years because of global pandemic COVID19, concluded this year with Gala event of achievements and celebrations.

Through 30+ hands-on experiments, the STEM program reached 190–196 children, transforming classrooms into spaces of curiosity and exploration.

Students actively participated, moving beyond fear to confidence in science and mathematics. ***From microscopes to self-made models; learning became real, joyful, and meaningful.***

## VaaGaLe - Parikh Foundation

.....

In the classrooms of Palanpur, **1898** young hearts began a journey from silence to self-expression. ***Through 120 Nature Club and 96 Roopantar sessions, learning flowed beyond books—into nature, values, and life itself.*** With every story read and every game played, children discovered their voice and confidence. Small gestures touched deeply— children embraced hygiene and self-care with dignity.



## School on Wheels

.....



***Over 50+ schools and 10,000 children were reached through our innovative School on Wheels initiative, bringing experiential learning to underserved communities.***

The project enabled large-scale impact with **72,710** nail cutters distributed across **402 schools**, promoting hygiene and health awareness. Environmental and social learning were strengthened through **10,580 saplings** plantation drives and Peace Games, creating a holistic ecosystem of learning, health, and values for rural children. Additionally, **8,700+** children were sensitized on food waste and introduced to AI & VR learning experiences, making education future-ready and meaningful.

***Together, the initiative created a joyful, engaging ecosystem where children not only learned—but began to think, question, and connect learning with real life.***

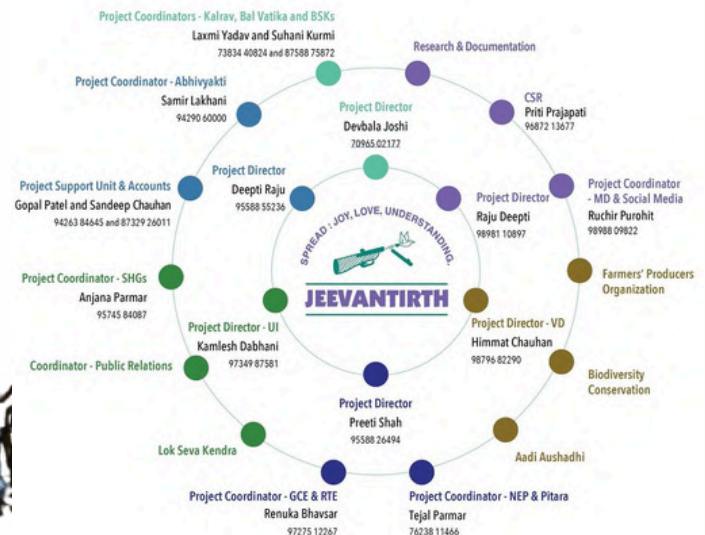
